In recognition of Eastern Nazarene College's 2+2 programs in Business Management and Early Childhood/Elementary Education, the division of Adult and Graduate Studies is pleased to offer an annual scholarship to an exceptional student in each 2+2 program (BAM, B.Ed. and MSM).

The 2+2 Scholarship will award the recipient with a 50% tuition reduction throughout the duration of the degree program. To qualify for consideration, the prospective recipient must:

- Earn an associate's degree from the partner community college.
- Gain admission to the Eastern Nazarene College's 2+2 program.
- Earn a 3.5 GPA from the associate's program, and continue to maintain a 3.5 for the duration bachelor completion program.
- Exemplify academic excellence in the classroom, as illustrated by exceptional scholarship, positive contribution to the classroom environment and positive relationships with classmates and faculty.
- Demonstrate service to the community, including engagement in the school, local community and church.
- Articulate career goals for which the bachelor's degree will be instrumental.

Candidates will submit a 500 word essay providing evidence of these standards, as well as other supporting materials, such as transcripts and letters of recommendation. A joint committee from ENC and the partner community college will review candidate materials and award a recipient.
